- A. **Wilson OmniFile:Full Text Select**
A multidisciplinary, 100 % full-text database providing full text articles, with their accompanying indexing and abstracts. Includes approximately 250 education journals
- B. **Professional Development Collection**
A specialized collection of journal articles and pamphlets especially for professional educators that includes abstract and index coverage for 435 professional development titles.
- C. **Research Library**
Choose **GALILEO Edition** to avoid crossover journals already found in **Professional Development Collection**
